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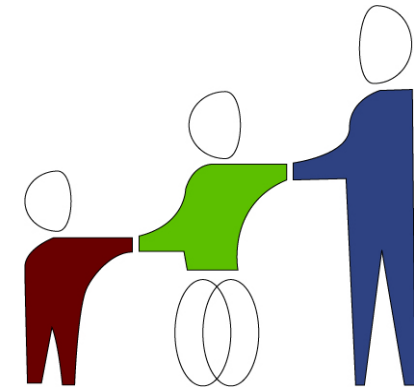

Vocational School

- 3 year phase (10th to 12th year of school)
- Compulsory vocational school attendance
- Getting prepared for adult life
- Enhancing and strengthening self-confidence and confidence about the future

Vocational school curriculum and tuition

- Areas of training: work and job, spare time and public life, residing, mobility, personality and social relations and interaction
- Orientation on job and life related issues
- Activity oriented tuition
- Project oriented tuition on and outside school premises
- Stabilization of reading and maths skills

Key Skills

In vocational school important life skills are trained:

- Personal Competence: e. g. motivation, endurance
- Social and communicative competences: e. g. politeness, ability to work in a team, capacity to accept criticism
- Cognitive Competence: e. g. concentration, ability to plan

Mobility Training

Students train to handle every-day situations

- to go shopping on their own
- to walk to certain known destinations on their own
- to ride the city bus on their own

Residing and Residential Training

Students try out and experience living in a small group during a residential training week at the Jugend- und Bildungshaus (House of Youth and Education) in Tegernbach.

Students learn for working life:

"The practical skills day"

Two days of the week are "practical skills days". During classes students are taught practical and theoretical knowledge and skills relevant for their future working lives.

Special Projects:

- Students' Café: Students run a café at our school and train all related work
- Stall at Pfaffenhofen's Christmas Market
- Practical Training: e. g. shoe shining, car interior cleaning, house cleaning, gardening, etc.

Internship

After finishing school most of our students work at a workshop for people with disabilities or attend a life aid institution in our district.

To help our students get ready for this phase of their lives, they take internships:

- 11th and 12th year of school: one week internship
- Internships on regular labor market can be taken at any time

Augmented Employment

From their 11th year of school on some of our students have the chance to participate in augmented employment projects. Integrational Services, district office Ingolstadt organize internships in coordination with our school to offer our students a chance for integration in the regular labor market via long term internships. We are happy to inform you about the details!

Planning Life after School

School, curative pedagogical day care center and parents help our students to find options and perspectives for their lives after school and support them in trying out new paths and making their own decisions for their future.
